MUNICIPALITY**

1.0 INTRODUCTION.

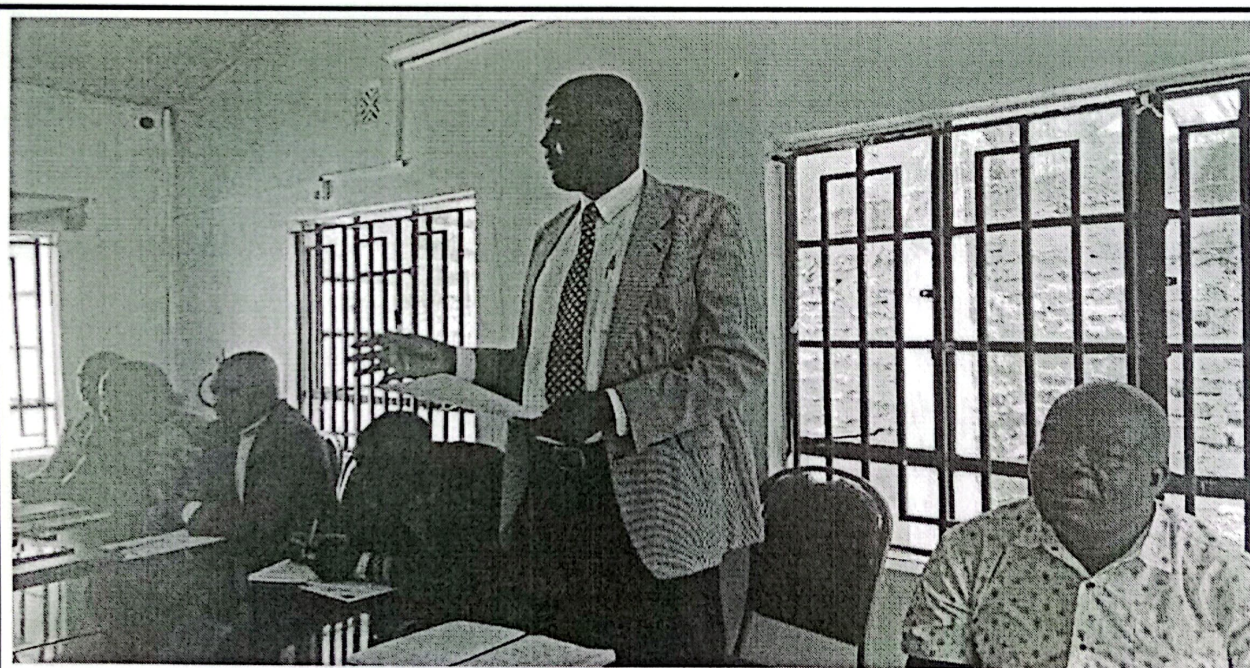
1.1 Overview.

Public participation is a legal requirement which is anchored in the Constitution of Kenya 2010, Urban Areas and Cities (Amendment) Act 2019, County Government Act 2012 among other pieces of legislations. Urban Areas and Cities (Amendment) Act 2019 mandates the Board to ensure participation of the municipality residents in decision making in its activities, projects and programmes undertaken within its jurisdiction.

In compliance to the above legislations, Migori Municipal Board organized a citizen forum on September 26th 2023 at IFAD Hall, Migori Municipality. The objective of the forum was to update the municipality residents on the completed and ongoing municipal projects, receiving views of the residents on the challenges they are facing within the municipality and their priority issues to be implemented by the Board in the next financial year.

1.2 Preliminaries.

The meeting was called to order at exactly 10: 25 am by the Board chairman Mr. Nelson Mandela who then called Mr. Ongoro to offer a word of prayer. After the prayer, the Municipal Manager, Mr. Dismas Owino was called to do introductions and welcome the members in the municipality.

The members present were introduced and welcomed to present their views and opinions in the following order:

1. Women league.
2. People with disability.
1. Boda-boda.
2. Taxi Operators
3. Development partners- bank managers.
4. Business community.
5. Professionals- Teachers.
6. Religious community.
7. Security. (National and County Government)
8. Board members.
9. County employees.
10. Informal business owners.

2.0 OVERVIEW OF THE MUNICIPAL MILESTONES AND PROGRAMMES.

After introduction of all the members present, the Municipal manager was then invited to update the municipal residents on the municipal milestones and give an overview of the completed and ongoing projects/programmes within the municipality.

The municipal manager began by giving an overview of the municipality, its establishment and operationalization. He further appreciated the County Government of Migori for the great effort they have put in place to ensure creation and operationalization of the municipalities. In addition to the above, the manager brought to the attention of the municipal residents the development partners specifically the World Bank who have funded various infrastructural projects in its three Phases (I, II and III) of partnership within the municipality including but not limited to

- ❖ Construction of Ombo Modern Market.
 - ❖ Upgrading of various municipal roads to bitumen standard (Gilly – KCB, Main Bridge – Behind Oasis – NCBA bank and Posta – Migori Mortuary Road among others)
 - ❖ Beautification of County Headquarters Entrance
 - ❖ Completion of Kakrao Market ablution block
 - ❖ Partnership with KURA to upgrade Murang'a road to bitumen standard.
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- ❖ Land banking for development of a modern bus terminus.
- ❖ Survey and beaconing of Kakrao market.
- ❖ Partnership with African Development Bank (ADB) to construct Marindi market.
- ❖ Survey of Ombo – Juakali bridge under partnership with State Department of Urban Development.

Finally, the manager informed the municipal residents of the ongoing projects of constructing a recreational facility at the public parcel in front of the Department of Water offices along Huduma Centre Ombo Hospital Road. This recreational facility once completed will improve the aesthetic image of the municipality and offer ample recreational site for the municipal residents to sit and relax. In addition to the above, the manager also informed the residents of the ongoing project of electrification of Ombo Modern Market. The project once completed will enable traders to undertake a variety of businesses which purely relies on power for operation.

3.0 PRESENTATION FROM THE RESIDENTS.

3.1 Overview.

The Municipal Board chairperson – Planning and Technical Committee; Mr. Daniel Frank Otieno was welcomed to take the members through the presentation session. He informed the residents that the citizen forum was the best means of engagement with the public within the Municipality emphasizing that the agenda of the meeting was key since the projects identified by the public would be forwarded to the County Executive Committee for adoption and implementation in the 2023/2024 financial year. The public views were then presented as follows:

3.2 Migori Municipality Residents Presentation.

The Municipal Board chairperson – Planning and Technical Committee then invited the public to air out their views. The following views were brought to attention of the members:

1. Opening of all blocked access roads within the municipality. Key emphasis to be given to major service lanes within the municipality I.e., Road behind Cooperative bank.
2. Upgrading of poor municipal roads. The main emphasis to be on Main Bridge to Nyasare road, Huduma Centre to Ombo hospital road, Osaka – Marindi Market – Main Bridge Road.
3. Emphasis on completion of ongoing markets' construction which has promoted disorderly arrangement of traders. Key emphasis be on completion of Marindi Market.

4. Acquiring and securing more land in Migori Municipality to enable growth, expansion and development of the municipality.
5. Networking and partnership with the development partners within the municipality.
6. Provision of sewerage facilities for the municipal residents to ensure proper liquid waste management which has since been a problem with the municipality over time. A proposal of partnership with development partners was suggested for this high investment project.
7. Presence of trucks moving and parked along the narrow roads and the highway resulting to frequent accidents. Proper parking spaces be designated within the municipality.
8. Establishment of proper solid waste transfer stations and holding sites. This will enable proper management of solid wastes generated and dumped indiscriminately within the municipality.
9. Improvement of water connectivity and sanitation facilities within Migori municipality markets.

10. Street lighting within the municipality to mitigate frequent insecurity cases within the CBD.
11. Proper location of bodaboda shades within the CBD and undertaking beautification programmes including but not limited to painting of old CBD buildings and designing of standard municipal stalls for order and beauty.

12. Fencing and upgrading of Kababu Cattle Auction ring to ensure security of the land and full operationalization of the market.
13. Provide for critical social amenities and facilities in urban areas like social halls.
14. Planning and reorganization of plots in Migori CBD including introduction of fire breaks between plots.
15. Promotion of urban connectivity including provision of alternative routes across River Migori to control congestions witnessed in the CBD.

4.0 PRIORITIZED PROJECTS TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY

After intense deliberations the Municipal residents prioritized the following projects to be implemented in the next financial year:

- Solid and Liquid waste management in the municipality which will include installation of waste bins, purchase of waste skips, unclogging of blocked drainage channels and provision of a conventional sewerage system.

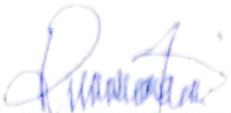


The municipal residents prioritizing preferred municipal projects

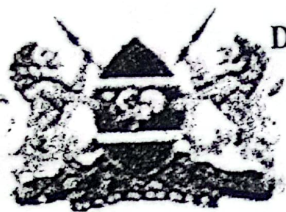
- Construction of Ombo Market – Juakali bridge to link the sub counties of Suna east and Suna west and ensure full operationalization of Ombo Modern Market.
- Provision of water and sanitation facilities in major municipal markets of Marindi, Kakrao and Namba markets.

- Upgrading to bitumen standard major municipal roads. Priority to be given to Main Bridge to Nyasare road, Huduma Centre to Ombo hospital road, Osaka – Marindi Market – Main Bridge Road.

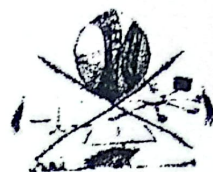

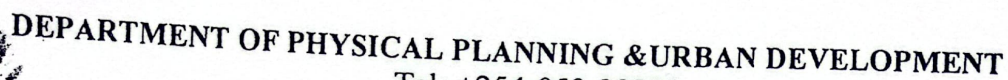

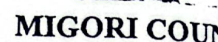
